### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Entries must be made on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form, signed by the actual owner or duly authorized agent and accompanied by appropriate entry fee (separate checks for multiple entries) in US Funds. Please make checks payable to Mid KY Kennel Club. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Collection fees will be added to the amount of each returned check. Do not send entries by any method which requires a signature for acceptance. Cancellation of entries must be made in writing and received prior to the stated close of entries.

In accordance with the AKC Obedience Regulations, entries shall be accepted up until the official closing date even though the advertised limit has been reached. A random drawing of all entries with preference given to dogs which have not previously earned an AKC TDX title to determine catalog order will take place on November 19, 2018, at 7 PM EST at 891 Red Fern Rd, Campbellsville, KY, and the public is invited. When the limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be drawn in the same manner and assigned a position on the alternate list. In the event the advertised limit is not reached, entries will be assigned catalog numbers in the order in which they were received, and a draw will not take place.

A worker draw will be used for this test in accordance with the parameters set forth in Chapter 1, Section 17d of the Tracking Regulations and as established by Mid-Kentucky Kennel Club and published in the August 2013 Meeting minutes. One track will be set aside for workers at this test.

All entries will be notified of their entry status and a Judging Program will be emailed and/or mailed as soon as practical after entries close and the draw is completed. Should you not receive such notification within a reasonable amount of time, please contact the Event Secretary.

In the event an accepted entry withdraws prior to the test date, the event secretary shall contact alternates according to their placement on the alternate list, and upon notification, said alternate shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. Entry fees will not be refunded for any reason other than for alternates who do not run and entrants replaced by an alternate at the test. Such entry fees will be destroyed within seven (7) days following the test date unless accompanied by an SASE, in which case they will be returned to the exhibitor.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have all appropriate vaccinations.

The Mid-Kentucky Kennel Club, its officers and representatives, the Event Chair/Secretary, Committee and the owner(s) of the Event site(s) assume no responsibility for loss of, damage to, or injury sustained by spectators or exhibitors, their property and/or their dogs and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. ### **AGREEMENT**

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. ### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
